■ United Way needs Boots and Books for Danbury Public School Readiness Program

The Danbury School Readiness Program is offered through the Danbury Public Schools for children ages 3 and 4 to increase school readiness among lower income families in the city. Many of the children don’t have the appropriate footwear that allows them to get out and play during the school day during the winter months. United Way of Western Connecticut (UWWC) is running a winter boot drive to provide boots for 60 children to be kept in the classroom to promote winter play.
