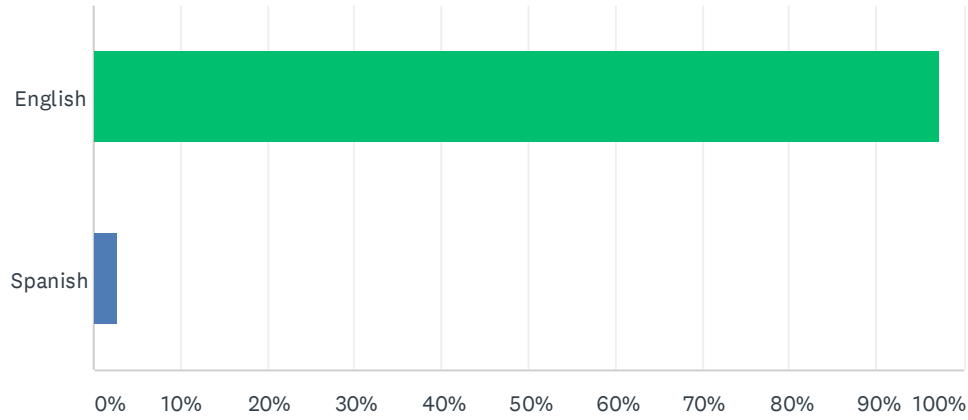

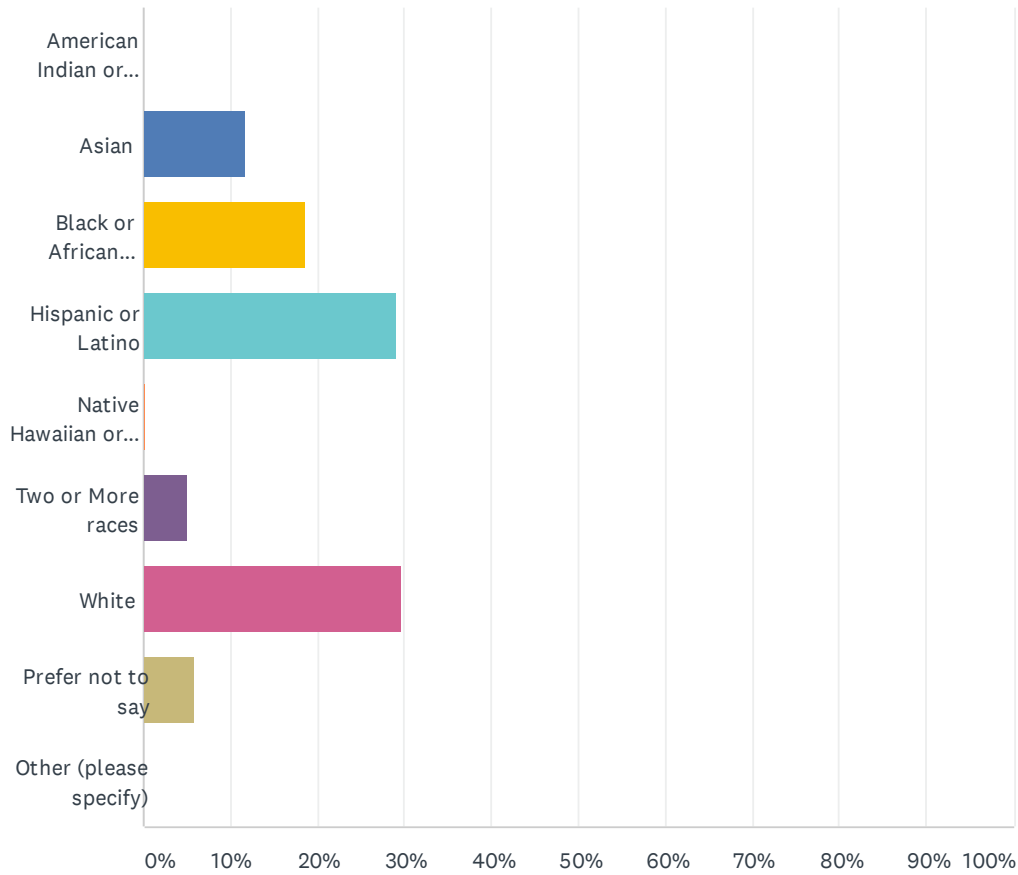

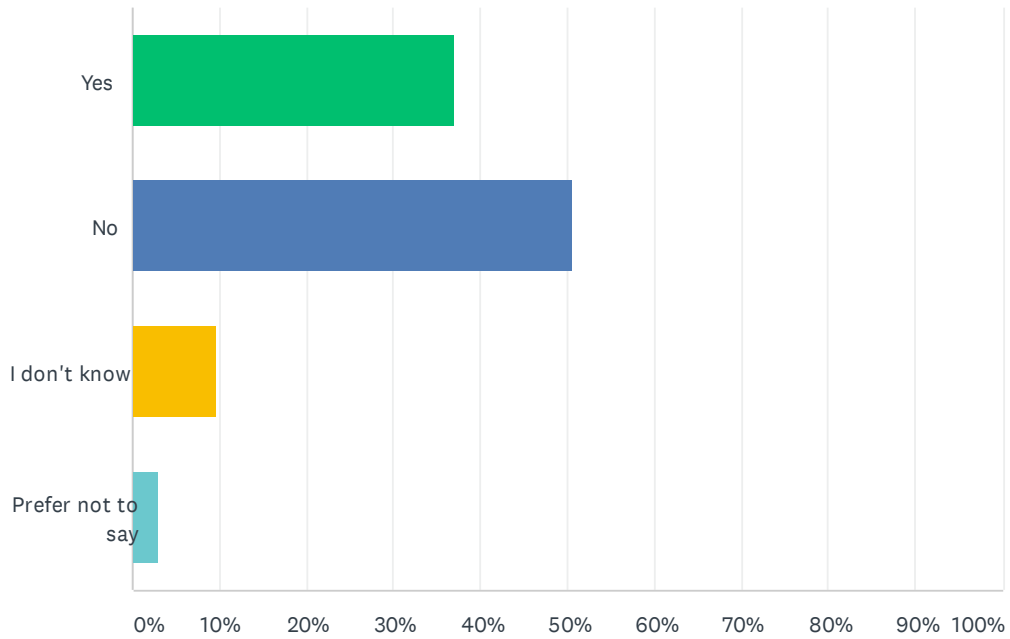

Q3 Are you free or reduced lunch?

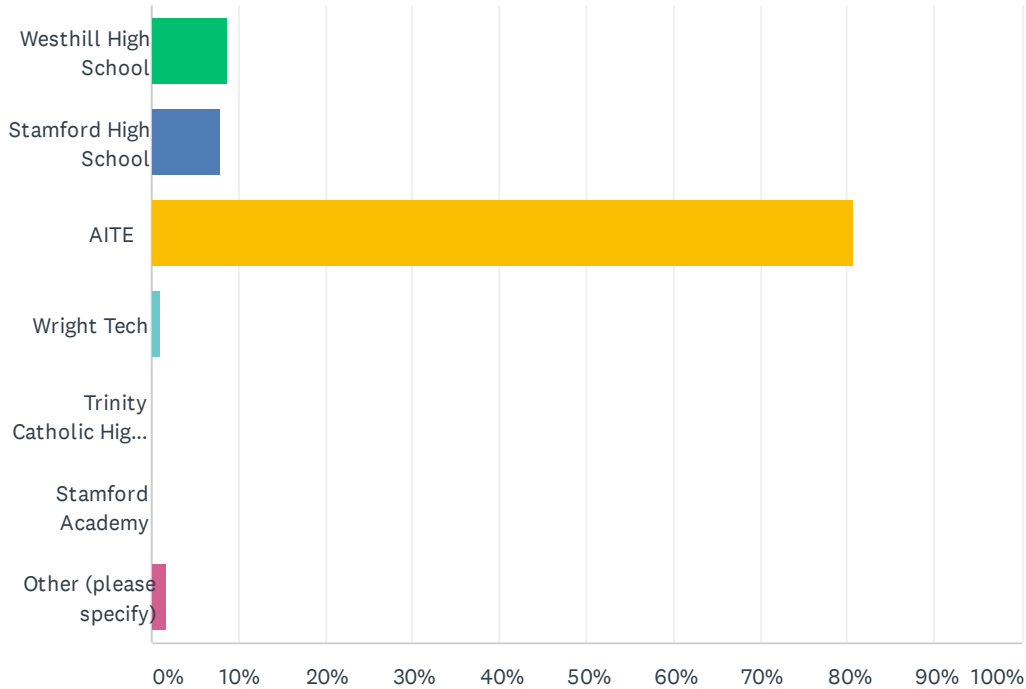

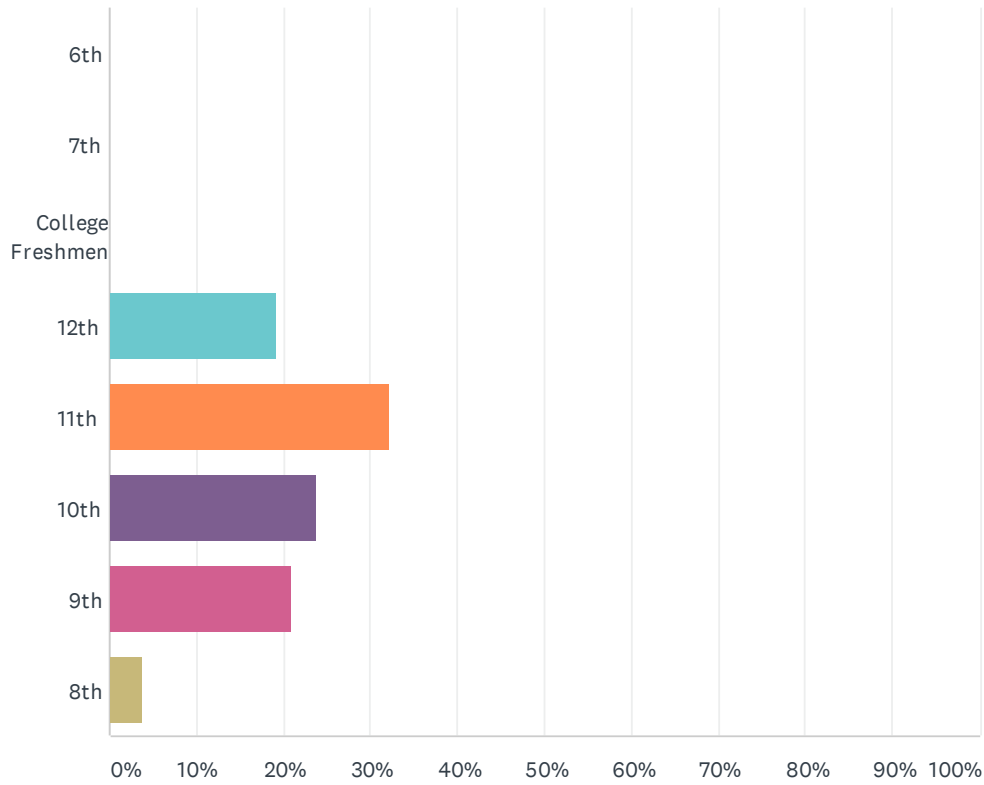

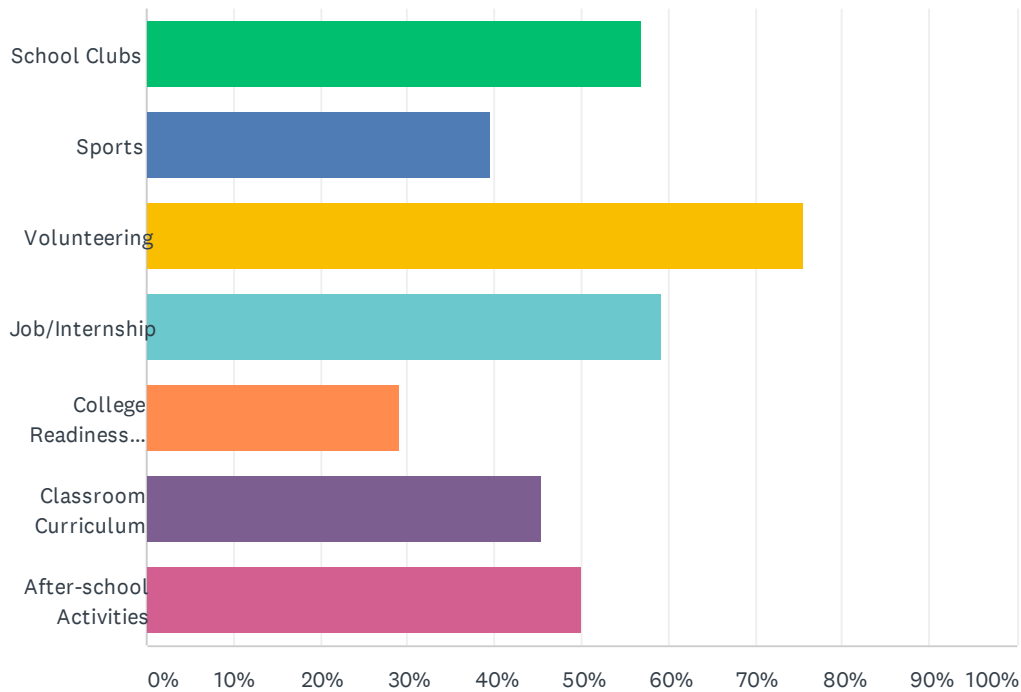

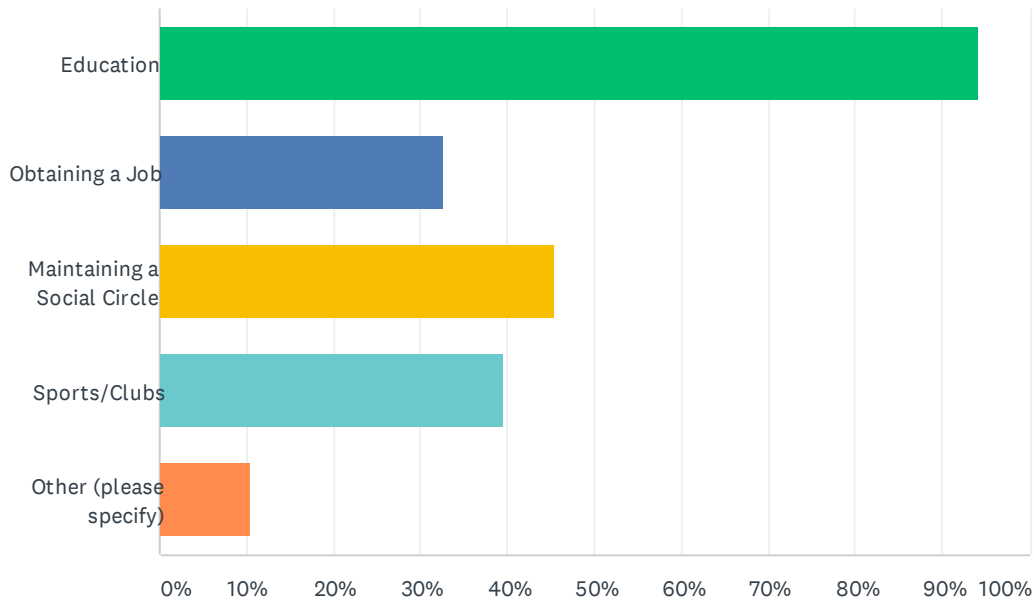

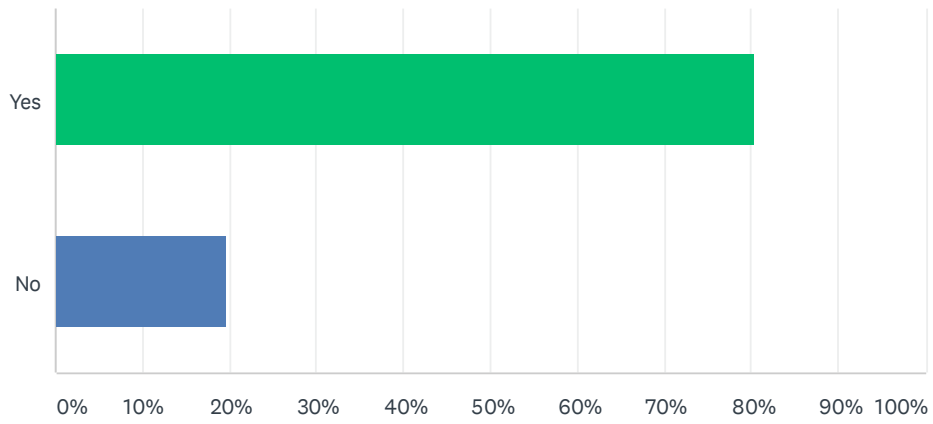
